Dr. Evangelia Kouidi is a Cardiologist, exercise physiologist, and Professor of Sports Medicine. She is also the Director of the Laboratory of Sports Medicine in School of Physical Education and Sports Science of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), Greece. She is the supervisor of the exercise rehabilitation programs of the Laboratory for renal, cardiac patients, and patients with other chronic diseases. She has memorable research experience on the effects of exercise training on cardiac morphology and function and skeletal muscle atrophy. She is a nucleus member and of the European Association of Rehabilitation in Chronic Kidney Disease (EURORECKD) and the Vice-President from 2016. She was also a Nucleus Member of the Exercise, Basic and Translational Research Section of the European Association of Cardiopulmonary Prevention and Rehabilitation (EACPR) of ESC (2006-2014). She has more than 150 publications in scientific journals and presented more than 100 lecturers in Scientific Congresses. She has been awarded seven times by the European Renal Association for her research and three times by FIMS and other medical Associations.
